Episode One (aka Week One) - Challenge 1 (of 2)

To play the Spectres of Benton County Clue Hunt and Mystery Game 'unconnected' so to speak, this is the place for you.

Each Challenge includes a series of PDF pages you print, that form the basis of the challenge's game. While the puzzles & quizzes will be slightly different from the connected versions of this game, the story, clues and mystery are the same.

In this Challenge are several images from the site of the first location, the Van Buren Bridge. Unfortunately, they are scrambled and need to be re-assembled before the quiz can be attempted. Answering the questions reveals a code giving you access to a recorded message. That is all for this package.



Jigsaw: Historical Marker @ Van Buren Bridge






Quiz: Contact George




- 1. The last digit of the year the second highest flood happened.

THE REST OF THE STORY

When closed, each end of the swing span rested on two steel rollers that sat on top of cast iron "shoes" mounted on the concrete end-piers. Gravity latches held the bridge closed. During a fierce wind storm on January 25, 1914, the latches loosened enough to allow the wind to blow the bridge of its shoes...at just the moment when a local boy was crossing on the center span.

Local boat tenders eventually heard the cries of George Way, a dishwasher at the Julian Hotel, who was stranded on the op span. At "no small risk to themselves," the boatmen managed to reach the bridge and engage the mechanism to close the bridge and bring the young man to safety.

Why would George be venturing out on such a fierce and stormy night? Surely he would have been aware of the bridge slowly being swung open by the wind? What was he preoccupied with as he lingered on the bridge? Clearly something was afoot – at the Courthouse, he feared...
