# Episode One - Challenge 2 (of 2)

## On the Ground

**In Google Maps (or your favorite map app)** Put in the following coordinates: 44.565302, -123.262055, and either print out the directions, or use the app on your phone to help you reach your next location.

When you arrive, you are looking for a Historical Marker. On this marker, there is information regarding an auspicious individual.

Who is the marker commending?

Next, look for a flyer box, and take out a flyer.

The document contains a number of details which tells more about the mystery you are helping to unravel. It will also come in handy for future reference. ;)


One confession demands that you reflect on it.

overnight in the safe.




